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RE Official information request WCDHB 9156

We refer to your email dated 14 June 2018 requesting the following information under section 12 of the Official Information Act (the 'Act') from West Coast.

For the last five years:

Would you please be able to provide me with?

- 1. The amount/number of drug-related visits to A&E?***

If that doesn't work, maybe toxins? - in terms of overdose, spiked/drugged, or illicit-substance in their system?

If they don't disclose that specifically, could you please see how many people had been admitted to the hospital for drug-related causes? - Or if they maybe disclose if the reason was due to overdose, spiked/drugged/, or illicit substance in their system.

And if that fails too, would you be able to see the above mentioned information in regards to emergency ambulance call outs?

Response:

Please refer to **Table one** (overleaf) for the information you have requested regarding cases recorded as drug-related visits to the Emergency Department at Grey Base Hospital over the past five years. The term 'drug' covers both prescribed medication and non-prescribed substances. We are unable to distinguish between "deliberate overdose / accidental ingestion" cases versus "spiked /drugged by others", as our information database does not hold this level of detail. With these points about our available data noted, the number of presentations recorded for intentional drug overdose and recreational drug use with complications were as indicated in the table overleaf.

2017/18 *	63	0.58%

West Coast DHB does not hold any data on the number of emergency ambulance call outs undertaken by St John we are therefore declining to provide this information under section 18(g) of the Official Information Act.
