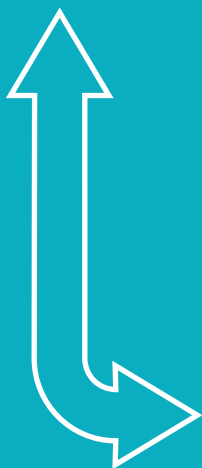

Park & Ride to Hospital

Car parking is available at the Deans Ave car park (Old Sale Yards). Parking costs \$5. A free shuttle runs between the car park and Hagley Outpatients and the Christchurch Hospital Main Entrance every 15 minutes from 7 am to 8.30 pm, 7 days a week.

The shuttle is not suitable for wheelchairs. If you have mobility restrictions please use either the mobility parking spaces near the main entrance, or have someone drop you off in the Drop-off zone.



Drop-off at Hospital

Have someone drop you off outside the main entrance in the designated Drop-off zone. Your driver can return to collect you at an agreed time, or they can park at the Deans Ave car park (Old Sale Yards) and then walk, or catch the free shuttle back to the hospital.

Volunteers will be at the main entrance to help you get to your appointments on time.

Please remember, there is NO waiting in the Drop-off zone.

Mobility Parking at Hospital



If you are a mobility parking permit holder you can park in one of the designated mobility spaces located outside the front of the hospital (refer to map).

* Your permit does not allow you to park illegally or to park for free where charges are indicated.
